

Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015

Eligibility Criteria for Chairperson and Members of Child Welfare Committees and Juvenile Justice Boards, State of Punjab

The application shall be submitted

- i) To the Directorate Social Security and Women & Child Development Department, SCO 102-103, Sector 34- A Chandigarh by 30.04.2021 till 5:00 PM
- ii) A separate application shall be submitted for each post.
- iii) Application shall be submitted in the prescribed format with all the supporting documents.
- iv) Incomplete applications shall be considered as disqualified.
- v) The applications of candidates who applied against the advertisement dated 23. 02.2021 shall be considered and shall not apply again.

JUVENILE JUSTICE BOARD consists of one Principal Magistrate and two social workers of which at least one is a woman, as per Section 4 of Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015

Eligibility Criteria for Social Workers/Member of Board

- (1) The applicant shall not be less than 35 years of age.
- (2) The applicant shall have at least seven years experience in health, education, or welfare activities pertaining to children or shall be a practicing professional with a degree in child psychology, psychiatry, sociology or law.
- (3) No person shall be eligible for selection as a member of the Board, if he—
 - (i) has any past record of violation of human rights or child rights;
 - (ii) has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude, and such conviction has not been reversed or has not been granted full pardon in respect of such offence;
 - (iii) has been removed or dismissed from service of the Central Government or a State Government or an undertaking or corporation owned or controlled by the Central Government or a State Government;
 - (iv) has ever indulged in child abuse or employment of child labour or any other violation of human rights or immoral act.
 - (v) has been appointed as a member of the board for maximum of two terms, which shall not be continuous.
- (4) The applicant should not :-
 - (i) be holding such full time occupation that may not allow to give necessary time and attention to work of the Board or Committee as per the Act and Rules.
 - (ii) be associated with any Child Care Institution, directly or indirectly, during his tenure as a member of the Board or Committee or have any other conflict of interest.
 - (iii) hold any office in any political party during his tenure, or
 - (iv) be insolvent.

- (5) The appointment of any member of the Board, may be terminated after holding an inquiry by the State Government, if he :-
- (i) has been found guilty of misuse of power vested under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act; or
 - (ii) has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude and such conviction has not been reserved or he has not been granted pardon in respect of such offence;
 - (iii) fails to attend the proceedings of the Board consecutively for three months without any valid reason; or
 - (iv) fails to attend less than three-fourth of the sittings in a year; or
 - (v) becomes ineligible as per point no. 3 and 4, during his term as a member.

Term of Members of the Board:

- (1) The term of the social worker/ member of the Board shall not be more than for a period of three years from the date of appointment.
- (2) The members may resign at any time, by giving one month's notice in writing to the State Government.

Child Welfare Committee consists of a Chairperson, and four other members of whom at least one is a woman and another, an expert on the matters concerning children as per Section 27 of Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015.

Eligibility Criteria

- (1) The applicant shall not be less than 35 years of age.
- (2) The applicant shall have at least seven years of experience in health, education or welfare activities pertaining to children or is a practicing professional with a degree in child psychology or psychiatry or social work or sociology or human development or in the field of law or a retired judicial officer
- (3) No person shall be eligible for selection as a member of the Committee if he—
 - (i) has any past record of violation of human rights or child rights;
 - (ii) has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude, and such conviction has not been reversed or has not been granted full pardon in respect of such offence;
 - (iii) has been removed or dismissed from service of the Central Government or a State Government or an undertaking or corporation owned or controlled by the Central Government or a State Government;
 - (iv) has ever indulged in child abuse or employment of child labour or any other violation of human rights or immoral act.
 - (v) has been appointed as a member of the Committee for maximum of two terms, which shall not be continuous.
- (4) The applicant should not :-
 - (i) be holding such full time occupation that may not allow to give necessary time and attention to work of the Board or Committee as per the Act and Rules.
 - (ii) be associated with any Child Care Institution, directly or indirectly, during his tenure as a member of the board or committee or have any other conflict of interest.
 - (iii) hold any office in any political party during his tenure, or
 - (iv) be insolvent.
- (5) The appointment of any member of the Committee shall be terminated by the State Government after making an inquiry, if he:-
 - (i) has been found guilty of misuse of power vested of him under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act;
 - (ii) has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude and such conviction has not been reserved or he has not been granted pardon in respect of such offence;
 - (iii) fails to attend the proceedings of the committee consecutively for three months without any valid reason or
 - (iv) fails to attend less than three –fourths of the sittings in a year;
 - (v) becomes ineligible as per point no. 3 and 4, during his term as a member.

Term of Members of the Committee:

- (1) No person shall be appointed for a period of more than three years as member of the committee
- (2) The Chairperson and members may resign at any time, by giving one month's notice in writing to the State Government

Note:- In case of any ambiguity in above mentioned criteria, the criteria mentioned in Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 shall prevail.
